#### DESCRIPTION

• GranoFlex® is a high performance acrylic jointing compound specifically designed for application to Fibre Cement Sheeting.

#### PRINCIPAL CHARACTERISTICS

- Suitable for exterior use only.
- Applied by trowel or spackle knife with the addition of 20% grey builders cement by volume.
- GranoFlex®, used in conjunction with GranoMesh, allows quick and easy filling of fibre cement joints in one application and with very little shrinkage on curing.
- GranoFlex® has passed accelerated weathering tests for fibre cement sheet materials by James Hardie and CSR Building Products.

• Blue. Blue-grey when mixed with cement.

#### RECOMMENDED SUBSTRATE CONDITIONS AND TEMPERATURE

- GranoFlex® is designed for use on the joints between the fibre cement sheets.
- Surface Preparation is the responsibility of the Builder, Renovator or Main Contractor and the Applicator. To achieve the
  indicated performance, application must be carried out according to Wattyl's recommendations.
- Ensure the surface is clean and dry. All substrates must be free of dirt, grease, oil, mould, release agents, bondbreakers or any other contaminants that may interfere with adhesion. There must be less than 15% moisture content in the surface at the time of coating to ensure optimum coating performance.
- Application should not be carried out if the air temperature or the substrate temperature is below 10°C or above 35°C. The temperature must not fall below 10°C during the drying process.
- Freshly applied material must be protected from frosts and rain for a minimum of forty eight (48) hours.

#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

- Stir contents thoroughly with a power stirrer before use.
- Thoroughly mix 20% (3 litres per 23kg of GranoFlex®) grey builders cement by volume into the GranoFlex® ensuring the cement is lump free.
- Position the GranoMesh into the joint and using a trowel or spackle knife spread the GranoFlex® into the joint totally encapsulating the GranoMesh.
- Finish level with the board. Allow 24 hours to dry before top coating.
